

Producing a Stop Motion film

Producing a stop motion film is a simple but creative way to put across a message to people.

Today we would like to challenge you to produce a stop motion film about your top tips for surviving isolation!

To put together your film, you might want to think about the following things:

- Spell words out in creative ways. You could use scrabble pieces, post it notes, or any other kind of letters you have around the house. Be creative!
- Create drawings to help show your message. Do you want to take pictures with the app to show the different stages of the drawing being created?
- Can you use other images or props that you have around the house/
- Do you have any lego or other items that you could use to slowly build things with in your video?

Remember the more often you take pictures, the longer the film will be. If you take them regularly it can also help make the movement look really smooth.
