Use the help sheet to help with your work.

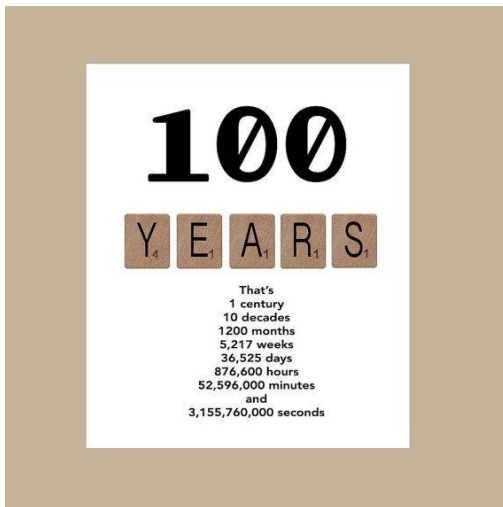
